RULES and PROCEDURES

Drawing Exhibition:

Entries must be on 8.5” x 11” white paper. Contestants are free to use the art medium of their choice (e.g. coloured pencils, paint, water colours). It is suggested the students put their first name on the drawings, as well as their age and the Italian School they belong to.

Spelling Bee:

1. The Pronouncer enunciates slowly clearly the word to be spelled. He/She uses the word in a sentence and then says the word again. He/She will also translate the word into English.
2. The Speller listens carefully to the Pronouncer and can ask for the word to be repeated, if necessary.
3. When the Speller is sure he/she understands the word, he/she pronounces it, types it on a computer and then says the word again. He/She must say it loudly enough for the judge(s) to hear it. The speller needs to be confident with their answer.
4. The judge(s) determine(s) whether or not the word was spelled correctly. The decision of the Judge(s) is final.
 - 5a. If the correct spelling was given, the speller remains in the game.
 - 5b. If the spelling was incorrect, the speller is eliminated from the game. The judge(s) gives the correct spelling of that word. Then the Pronouncer reads a new word to the next student.
6. When there are only two spellers left, if one player misspells a word, the other player must spell that word correctly, plus one more word to be declared the winner of the spelling bee.

All those interested in participating must submit the completed Application Form to their teachers.
