### CONTEST RULES AND PROCEDURES

The contest is open to:

- Students from 4 to 13 years of age studying Italian at Frank Ryan International Languages Program and at Centro Giovanile Formativo ItaloCanadese (school administration will decide whether entries will be prepared as a classroom activity or homework);
- Children of the same age group in the community at large.

Entries will be on 8½" x 11" white paper.

Contestants are free to use the art medium of their choice (e.g. coloured pencils, paint, water colours).

The title, in Italian, must be clearly displayed on the front along with the artwork.

Contestants' information will appear on the back: name, age, address, telephone number, the name of the Italian language school (where applicable) and grade.

The application form, signed by a parent or guardian, must accompany the drawing.

Entries will be submitted no later than March 7, 2015.

Contestants attending the Italian language schools are asked to hand in their drawings to their teachers. All other entries can be left at:
